WINNERS will be notified by end of February and honored at the awards ceremony to be held at the Banquet on April 3, 2020.

**Eligibility:** Assistant Professors within 6 years of their first independent position are eligible. A letter from their respective Department chairperson or Institute Director confirming their eligibility should also be attached to their application during the submission.
