Having diversity in the panel of speakers is encouraged.

We also want to encourage growth of SNIP membership and *inclusion of no more than two non-member speakers who would be first-time attendees* and then would join the society to attend future meetings is highly encouraged. There is modest financial support for each symposium to support this goal.

Do not confirm with the speakers at this time. The SNIP Meetings Committee is tasked with selecting and confirming the symposia for SNIP 2026. Until that occurs, no speakers can be confirmed.
